You can stop it at any time. Auge remains on your screen until you turn it off or until it counts down to 20. When Auge counts down to zero, it displays "Stop Auge." It cannot be restarted. If you are working with another application, Auge will not interrupt or stop your work. Auge was designed for Microsoft Windows XP and later, but it can be used on older operating systems. Auge may not run on Macs or other non-Microsoft computers. You can turn Auge off, or change the interval between reminders.
